Volunteer application for everyone

- * **COMPLETE REGISTRATION** (required BEFORE player is assigned to a team)
 - * Birth certificates must be checked for all new players
 - * Payment must be received
 - * Volunteer application
- * Season is from March 7th thru May 9rd
- * Shinguards must be worn during games and practice
- * Soccer cleats are recommended (no baseball or football cleats)
- * No jewelry or hard barrettes, beads, balls in hair
- * Uniform includes jersey, shorts, socks

* **Info / Requirements**

- * Team roster release February 25
 - * Coaches & parents are notified
 - * Suggest team meeting shortly afterward to identify team volunteers
- * Uniforms available week of March 2
 - * Coach provides list of team volunteers to pickup uniforms

* Team Information & Uniform Distribution

- * **Need Volunteer coaches to create teams**
- * Players are assigned to teams based on age and years of soccer experience
- * Can I be placed on the same team as friend?
 - * Yes, but only in U5 - U7 Divisions
 - * Parents requesting to be assigned on team must take a key volunteer role (Coach, Referee (U7), Asst. Coach)
 - * Let your commissioner know
 - * Complete required certification
- * Coach setup first team meeting
 - * Parents select remaining team volunteers positions
 - * Asst. coach, Referee (U8), Field setup, referee, SnackBar, Team parent
 - * Agree on practice day
 - * Decide on a team name
 - * Activate [Shutterfly team website](#)

* Team Assignment U5 - U7 Divisions

- * Need Volunteer coaches to create teams
- * TEAMS BALANCING
 - * Players are evaluated prior to team assignment. **MUST** attend one date
- * NOT a tryout. All registered players will be assigned to a team
- * Contact your Division Commissioner if your child is unable to attend
- * Can I be placed on the same team as my friend?
 - * NO
- * Need Volunteer coaches to create teams

***Team Assignment**
U9 and older Divisions

- * Coaches and players arrive 30 min prior to scheduled time
- * Coaches prepare team. Warm up, game plan
- * Parents setup field of play
 - * Goals, Flags, Cones
 - * Take down goals at the end of the match
- * Coaches Coach
- * Players Play
- * Parents Cheer
- * Don't be a sideline coach

* Game Day Activities

- * **Season schedule** will be posted March 1 at www.ayso1031.org
 - * Parents will be notified of schedule changes
 - * ON TIME IS LATE. ARRIVE 30 min prior to start time
 - * U5 and U7 games will be Saturdays 8:30am
 - * U12 games will start at 8:30am
 - * U10 games will start at 10:00am Saturdays. Some Sunday games will be scheduled (11:00 start time)
- * **Practice schedule**
 - * Decided by coach and team
 - * Coach complete practice request form
 - * First come basis
 - * Available practice slots 5:00, 6:00pm, *7:00 (based on availability)

* **Schedules**

- * Each Team **MUST** have the following volunteers:
- * Coach
- * Assistant coach
- * Field Set-up - set-up / take down goals, flags, cones
- * Snack Bar
- * Field monitor
- * Team Parent - maintain roster / snack schedule, set up Shutterfly team website, organize season-end party, support picture day and trophy distribution
- * Referee(U7 only) - ref your child's game

- * On-line course followed by in-class session; workbook for new referees.
- * Youth Referee Program (ages 12 and up)
- * AYSO referees are volunteers, so we want to be sure they have as much fun as the players do.

* **Referees**

Next course March 9th 6:00pm - 9:00pm

- * Respect your coach's time
 - * ON TIME is late
 - * Arrive 10 - 15 min before practice
 - * Arrive 30 min before game
 - * Call, email, text if you are late for practice or games
 - * Use the shutterfly team website calendar to indicate player availability
 - * KEEP THE COACH INFORMED OF YOUR CHILD'S AVAILABILITY
- * You are expected to stay with your child at practices
- * Respect the staff at the park
- * NO parking at the baseball fields
- * Our volunteers work full time jobs (non-AYSO)
